Dark Green Arborvitae



Narrow, pyramidal evergreen displaying dense emerald green foliage. Holds its foliage color throughout winter. Excellent medium to large hedge or screening plant.



Reaches 20 to 25 feet tall, 5 to 7 feet wide.



Full sun



Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system, requires less water once established.



- Do provide winter protection from drying winds to newly established plants.
- Do fertilize annually; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.



- Don't plant in heavy deer traffic areas; this native is a source of winter food for browsing deer.
- Don't plant in full shade as this will cause interior foliage to die off and the tree to stretch towards sun, eliminating its screening effect.
