

Fire Chief Arborvitae



A nearly perfectly globe-shaped shrub with fine, bright gold spring foliage and fantastic deep red fall color. A slow growing, low maintenance evergreen perfect for massing in a landscape foundation or as a rock garden specimen.



Reaches 2 feet tall and wide in 10 years; 4 feet tall and wide at maturity.



Full Sun



Water deeply, regularly during first few growing seasons to establish an extensive root system.

No pruning needed to maintain compact, rounded form



- Do plant in full sun, best form and health are achieved in full sun.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.



- Don't plant where exposed to high winter winds.
- Don't plant in high deer traffic areas; white cedar and its cultivars are favored by deer in the winter months.
