Green Giant Arborvitae:



A large, vigorous, fast-growing evergreen. Its natural pyramidal to conical form boasts dense, rich green foliage that darkens or bronzes slightly in the winter. This is an exceptional landscape tree for use as a screen, hedge or single specimen. It is also resistant to wind once established and can withstand heavy ice or snow, making it a good choice for a natural windbreak.



Quickly reaches 25-30 feet tall; 8-10 feet wide.



Partial Shade to Full Sun



Water regularly - weekly, or more often in extreme heat.

Many arborvitaes take on a nice pyramid shape without pruning. If you must prune then limit it to once a year and keep the following in mind:



- Prune in the fall or early winter.
- Ideally, main side branches should be at least 1/3 smaller than the diameter of the trunk.



- Never remove more than ¼ of a tree's crown in a season
- Prune in Summer; if pruned in the summer the tips of the pruned branches may turn brown
