
Mr. Bowling Ball Arborvitae



Full Sun

A naturally rounded dwarf shrub with dense evergreen foliage. The lacy, rich green foliage has excellent year-round color retention. Useful as a low hedge and in foundation plantings. Especially useful in areas where space is limited.



Reaches 24-30 inches tall and wide.

Water deeply, regularly during the first growing season to establish an extensive root system. Fertilize in early spring. Prune lightly, only as needed to shape.



- Do plant in full sun, best form and health are achieved in full sun.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Don't plant where exposed to high winter winds.
- Don't plant in high deer traffic areas; white cedar and its cultivars are favored by deer in the winter months.
