
Techny Arborvitae



A broadly based pyramidal form having dense foliage that maintains its handsome dark green coloring all year. Excellent for medium to tall hedges or screens.



Slowly Reaches up to 12-15 feet tall; 6-8 feet wide.



Full to Partial Sun



Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Requires less water once established; water regularly in extreme heat.

Feed with a general purpose fertilizer before new growth begins in spring. For a tidy, neat appearance, shear annually to shape. Pruning time: spring.



- Do plant in full sun, best form and health are achieved in full sun.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.



- Don't plant where exposed to high winter winds.
- Don't plant in high deer traffic areas; white cedar and its cultivars are favored by deer in the winter months.
