## **Admiration Barberry**



Nothing does foliage interest like this stunning barberry bush. From spring until fall phenomenal shades of maroon, lime green, scarlet and gold foliage is what you can expect from this delightful and colorful shrub.



Moderate growing; reaches 2 feet tall and wide.





Full Sun to Partial Shade



Water regularly - weekly, or more often in extreme heat

Fertilize before new growth begins in spring. No pruning necessary except to maintain desired shape. Pruning time: winter.



- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.



- Don't plant in high foot traffic areas; the stems are armed with stout little spines while useful under windows to deter the unlawful, they can be a pain for the unintended.
- Don't plant in too shady to a site, especially the purple cultivars. Best foliage coloration is obtained in full sun sites
