

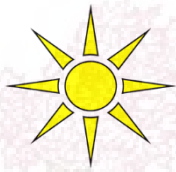
Green Velvet Boxwood



A full-bodied boxwood well-suited for dense, low hedges. Foliage retains its rich green color throughout winter. Develops a vigorous, rounded form if not pruned. A wonderful evergreen that will provide year-round, cold-hardy color and structure in the garden.



Reaches 3-4 feet tall and wide.



Partial to Full Sun



Water Regularly – Weekly or more in extreme heat or conditions



- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Don’t forget to provide antitranspirant/antidesiccant in late fall. This is especially important to new plantings or exposed sites.
- Don’t fertilize or prune too late in the season; we want new growth to harden off before the season first frost.
