Dwarf Burning Bush



A sensational accent or natural hedge prized for its intense scarlet red fall coloring. The interesting, compact, mounded form displays attractive rich green leaves spring through summer. Exceptional when featured en masse, at the foreground of larger conifers or evergreen shrubs.



Reaches 6-8 feet tall; 8-10 feet wide.



Full Sun



Water deeply, regularly during first growing season to establish an extensive root system; reduce frequency, once established.



- Do site in full sun for best growth and coloration however the plant is at home in a dappled shade environment.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in heavy deer/rabbit areas as winter browsing (feeding) can be severe.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
