
Celestial Dogwood



A small, upright, ornamental tree that will grace your landscape with loads of large snow-white flowers in spring and ruby-red foliage in fall. It is very vigorous and blooms heavily,



Reaches 20 feet high; 15 feet wide.



Full Sun to Partial Shade



Water regularly to maintain evenly moist soil - weekly, or more often.





- Do provide organic matter when backfilling rootball, adequate mulch layer and protection from hot afternoon sun.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and branches from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Don't plant in an exposed site; dogwood is typically found as an understory plant, protected from high winds and harsh sunlight.
- Don't neglect to thin the interior over time; dogwood thrives with good air circulation to interior structure.
