Cornelian Cherry Dogwood



Valued for early spring bloom; showy, small yellow flowers appear before green foliage emerges in spring. Makes an ideal hedge, screen or trained as a specimen in shrub borders. Tart, edible fruit. Deciduous.



Reaches 15-20 feet tall and wide.





Full Sun to Partial Shade



Water regularly to maintain evenly moist soil - weekly, or more often.



- Do provide organic matter when backfilling rootball, adequate mulch layer and protection from hot afternoon sun.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and branches from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in an exposed site; dogwood is typically found as an understory plant, protected from high winds and harsh sunlight.
- Don't neglect to thin the interior over time; dogwood thrives with good air circulation to interior structure.
