
Isanti Redosier Dogwood



A multi-stemmed shrub with a neat, compact habit. Blood-red stems are showy in winter, creamy white flowers appear in late May to early June and bluish-white fruit borne in late summer. A fast growing, easy-to-grow plant that thrives in moist situations. Ideal specimen plant and great for naturalizing.



Reaches 5-6 feet tall and wide



Full Sun to Partial Shade



Follow a regular watering schedule during the first growing season to establish a deep, extensive root system. Watering can be reduced after establishment.



- Do fertilize annually; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.
- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", avoid piling the mulch around the base and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".



• Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a plant under stress.
