


Princeton Elm



The 'Princeton' Elm is the classic American Elm reborn. Grows in a vase shaped and arching form reminiscent of elm lined small town streets. Dark green foliage and yellow fall color.



Reaches 50-70 feet tall; 30-50 feet wide.

- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and branches from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above. Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
