

# Japanese Forest Grass

Japanese forest grass is relatively low-growing (1 to 2 feet tall), with arching leaves that provide a sweeping appearance as though the plants were flowing. The plant will spread by rhizomes, but very slowly. It can be used as a ground cover for this reason



Reaches 12-14 inches high



Partial Sun to Full Shade



Water regularly to maintain evenly moist soil - weekly, or more often.



- Do provide adequate mulch for moisture retention.
- Do prune hard in late winter or very early spring, avoiding fresh spring shoots.
- Don't plant in dry, sunny, exposed sites. Avoid hot afternoon sun.
