

Maiden Grass



An attractive clumping ornamental grass with fine-textured, silver-green blades that turn golden-bronze after first frost. A great specimen for adding texture to shrub borders and perennial beds, or for massing as a screen.



Moderate growing; reaches 6 to 8 feet tall, 3 to 5 feet wide.



Full Sun



Water: Once established, water occasionally; more in extreme heat.



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do fertilize lightly every season, this perennial does not need a lot of extra care.
- Don’t prune perennial grass too late in spring or you will cut off the coming season’s new growth a chore best done in winter
- Don’t plant in too shady of a site; this perennial will handle full, hot sun.
