
Royal Family Holly



Deep emerald green, shiny evergreen foliage enhances everything around it. In spring white flowers appear, followed by massive amounts of cherry red berries. Its long lasting berries are perfect for holiday bouquets. A fantastic choice for a hedge or makes a stunning specimen. A selfpollinating combination, Royal Family Holly is a combination of Blue Prince Holly and Blue Princess Holly, both growing in the same pot guaranteeing you blooms and berries



Reaches 10 feet tall; 8 feet wide.

Water deeply, regularly in the first growing season to establish an extensive root system.



- Do provide antitranspirant/antidessicant in late fall. This is especially important to new plantings or exposed sites.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in exposed sites. Best growth occurs with protection from hot afternoon sun and drying winter winds.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
