This Hydrangea boasts big, showy blooms that quickly transform from pure white to a glorious pink, providing months of color. Handsome dark green foliage turns burgundy-red in autumn. This North American native is perfect for woodland gardens and informal plantings.



Reaches 6-8 feet high and wide.





Partial Sun to Full Sun



Water regularly to maintain evenly moist soil - weekly, or more often.





- Do prune during or directly after flowering; this will insure we are not cutting off future flowers.
- Do provide proper siting. Oakleaf hydrangea are shade oriented plants and need protection from hot afternoon sun.
- Don't place in an exposed, full sun site with minimal access to water.
- Don't forget to provide adequate mulch and annual fertilizer.
