

Glowing Embers Hydrangea



Large rounded clusters of enchanting pink blooms cover this upright, rounded shrub from summer through fall. It makes a charming companion to evergreen shrubs in foundation plantings or mass planted under tall trees.



Moderate grower to 6 feet tall and 6 to 8 feet wide.



Partial Sun



Needs regular watering - weekly, or more often in extreme heat.



- Do prune during or directly after flowering; this will insure we are not cutting off future flowers.
- Do provide proper siting. Bigleaf hydrangea are shade oriented plants and need protection from hot afternoon sun.
- Don't place in an exposed, full sun site with minimal access to water.
- Don't forget to provide adequate mulch and annual fertilizer.
