

Pee Wee Hydrangea



A dwarf, four-season shrub perfect for smaller gardens. Pee-Wee features white spring flowers that fade to pink, beautiful fall foliage, and cinnamon-colored bark in the winter. Superb as a specimen or foundation plant in borders or group plantings.



Moderate growing; reaches just 4 feet tall; 3 feet wide.



Partial sun



Water regularly to maintain evenly moist soil - weekly, or more often.



- Do prune during or directly after flowering; this will insure we are not cutting off future flowers.
- Do provide proper siting. Oakleaf hydrangea are shade oriented plants and need protection from hot afternoon sun.
- Don't place in an exposed, full sun site with minimal access to water.
- Don't forget to provide adequate mulch and annual fertilizer.
