

Twist & Shout Hydrangea



The first re-blooming lacecap hydrangea, boasts picturesque deep pink or periwinkle blue hydrangea flowers (depending on soil pH) from late spring through fall. With loads of dependable blooms and intense hydrangea colors, these lacecap hydrangea have become a favorite for everyone from new gardeners to Master Gardeners!



Reaches 3-5 feet tall and wide.



Partial Shade



Needs regular watering - weekly, or more often in extreme heat.



- Do prune during or directly after flowering; this will insure we are not cutting off future flowers.
- Do provide proper siting. Bigleaf hydrangea are shade oriented plants and need protection from hot afternoon sun.



- Don't place in an exposed, full sun site with minimal access to water.
- Don't forget to provide adequate mulch and annual fertilizer.
