
Blue Point Juniper



Glowing blue-green foliage on a densely branched, broad pyramid form that maintains its natural form well with practically no pruning. Clipped topiary forms make a wonderful formal accent in entrances or on patios.



Reaches 12 feet tall; 8 feet wide.

Full Sun



Water deeply, regularly during first growing season to establish an extensive root system; once established, water occasionally; more in extreme heat.



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in too shady of a site; this juniper will withstand hot afternoon sun, limited drought and is known to have good salt tolerance.
- Don't over water once established.
