

Grey Owl Juniper



A finely textured evergreen shrub with arching branches clothed in soft, silver-gray foliage. Very effective planted en masse, as a tall groundcover or low growing hedge. Requires little maintenance. Drought tolerant when established.



Reaches up to 3 feet tall; 6 feet wide.



Full Sun



Water: Once established, water occasionally; more in extreme heat.

Fertilize in early spring. For a tidy appearance, prune annually to shape.



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in too shady of a site; this cultivar of Michigan's red cedar will withstand hot afternoon sun and is known to have good salt tolerance.
- Don't over water once established.
