
## **Adelaide Dunbar Lilac**



The buds of this exceptional French hybrid lilac are an intense deep-purple hue, opening to lavender-pink double-flowers that are deliciously fragrant and appear in large clusters in the spring.



Reaches 4-6 feet tall and wide.



Full to Partial Sun



Water regularly in extreme heat for best performance. Requires less water once established.



- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above. Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".
- Do site in full sun, best growth flower are achieved with afternoon sun.



- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
