Nadezhda Lilac



Large panicles of very fragrant, double, lilac-blue flowers from rose-purple buds in late spring. Stunning blossoms have very large florets. Syringa 'Nadezhda' is a profuse bloomer, in flower for a good length of time.

Reaches 8 feet tall; 6-8 feet wide.

- Full to Partial Sun



Water regularly in extreme heat for best performance. Requires less water once established.



- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above.
 Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".
- Do site in full sun, best growth flower are achieved with afternoon sun.



- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
