
Butterflies Magnolia



Its green leaves are oval-shaped. The tuliplike, bright yellow flowers are 3 to 5 inches across and when fully open, they reveal vivid orange stamens. If temperatures are higher than normal during the flowering season, the flower color may be somewhat less intense. Each flower has up to 16 petallike tepals. The tree has an upright growth habit and develops a pyramid shape.



Reaches 18-20 feet high; 12-18 feet wide.

Once established, needs only occasional watering.





- Do keep pruning to a minimum; other than an odd branch here or there and deadwood you are free off such task with this tree.
- Do fertilize annually in spring when the flower buds begin to swell; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
