
Golden Gala Magnolia



Lemon-yellow, cup-shaped blooms with overlapping petals. Golden Gala has an upright, pyramidal shape. Rich green foliage throughout the season that turns yellow in the fall.



Reaches 20-30 feet high and wide.

Once established, needs only occasional watering.





- Do keep pruning to a minimum; other than an odd branch here or there and deadwood you are free off such task with this tree.
- Do fertilize annually in spring when the flower buds begin to swell; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade.
 A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
