
Jane Magnolia



The Jane Magnolia is a vigorous, upright tree/shrub that produces large, fragrant flowers. The flowers resemble slender tulips and are reddish-purple on the outside, white on the inside. This plant is generally grown in multi-stem form. Magnolias are classic small flowering ornamental plants great for any sunny garden situation. Enjoy this smaller variety that won't outgrow its bounds.



Reaches 8-10 feet high and wide.

Once established, needs only occasional watering.





- Do keep pruning to a minimum; other than an odd branch here or there and deadwood you are free off such task with this tree.
- Do fertilize annually in spring when the flower buds begin to swell; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
