

Sweetbay Magnolia



A handsome semi-evergreen tree with 2 to 3 in. creamy-white, lemon-scented flowers against a background of glossy green pointy leaves; turning yellow in the fall. The early fall fruits are showy red pods. A lovely small patio, shade or specimen tree.



Reaches to 12-20 feet tall and wide.



Full Sun to Partial Sun



Once established, needs only occasional watering.



- Do keep pruning to a minimum; other than an odd branch here or there and deadwood you are free off such task with this tree.
- Do fertilize annually in spring when the flower buds begin to swell; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
