
Yellow Lantern Magnolia



It typically grows as an upright, single-trunked, pyramidal to oval tree. Fragrant, tulip-shaped, creamy yellow flowers (to 6-8" across) with light pink tinges at the base bloom in spring as the new leaves emerge. The cup shaped blossoms have no hint of green.



Reaches to 25-30 feet tall; 10-15 feet wide.



Full Sun to Partial Sun



Once established, needs only occasional watering.



- Do keep pruning to a minimum; other than an odd branch here or there and deadwood you are free off such task with this tree.
- Do fertilize annually in spring when the flower buds begin to swell; a healthy plant is the best defense from pest/disease.



- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade.
 A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
