

Armstrong Gold Maple



Considered one of the best for early fall color! This large deciduous tree has a narrow, columnar form and glossy green leaves that turn brilliant yellow-orange in fall. An extremely showy specimen, lawn, park or street tree. Deciduous.



Rapidly reaches 35-40 feet tall; 12 feet wide.



Full sun



Once established, needs only occasional watering.



- Do apply an annual fertilizer in spring, following manufacturers' recommendations.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above. Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
