

Armstrong Maple



A tall, columnar, shade tree. Whether used as a single bold specimen or lined elegantly along your street, driveway, or property border, this low-maintenance tree will give your landscape structure all year long. Armstrong's fall color ranges from peachy-gold to a delightful mix of deep red, orange, and yellow.



Reaches 45 feet tall; 15 feet wide.



Full sun



Once established, needs only occasional watering.



- Do apply an annual fertilizer in spring, following manufacturers' recommendations.
- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above. Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
