The Knock Out® Family of Roses are the most disease resistant roses on the market making them easy to grow. All of the Knock Out® Roses are self-cleaning so there is no need to deadhead.



Reaches 3-4 feet tall and wide.



Full Sun



Needs regular water until established. Water deeply when you plant it and whenever the top 3 inches of soil are dry to encourage deep roots.

In the spring, after the threat of frost has passed, cut back your roses to about 12".



- Do fertilize annually, along with pruning your rose plantings will reward for many years.
- Do site in full sun, best growth and flower are achieved with afternoon sun.



- Don't neglect to thin the interior over time; the rose family thrives with good air circulation to interior structure.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
