

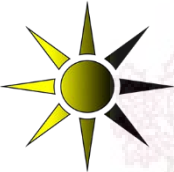
Japanese Spurge



Low & compact ground cover with glossy green leaves that retains its deep beauty even in adverse conditions. Hardy, easy to grow and maintenance free evergreen ground cover. This has long been the most reliable cool-season groundcover for shade. Perfect for planting under the canopies of older trees, where little else grows. A lifesaver on the north sides of walls or north-facing slopes, and between tall multistory buildings. Works very nicely in the front of shaded borders or as filler between larger shrubs. Dense enough to keep down weeds, it is a great solution for dark parts of the garden.



Slowly reaches 6-12 inches tall and wide.



Full to partial shade



Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.



- Do supplement water in dry spells.
- Do apply annual fertilizer for thick, full mats. Weeds will find it hard to grow through a well-established groundcover.



- Don't plant in too sunny of a location; best results are in shade to dappled shade.
- Don't allow fall's leaf debris to cover your plantings; this opens the door to next spring's disease.
