Moraine Sweetgum



A uniform and fast growing variety with a stunningly brilliant red fall color and a shapely oval form. This is the most cold hardy variety of Sweetgum, with excellent star shaped, glossy, dense green leaves. Moraine Sweetgum is a tall, spreading shade tree with interestingly shaped leaves that turn brilliant red in the fall, definitely a unique and great choice for any yard.



Reaches 70 feet tall; 50 feet wide.



Full Sun



Low trickle base to the root zone every other day for the first 2 weeks. Weaning to every 3rd week 1x per month; supplementing during times of drought.



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do apply mulch to a depth of 3-4", your mulch ring should be the same diameter as the canopy above. Avoid piling the mulch around the trunk and creating the unfortunate "mulch volcano".



- Don't forget to do an annual inspection looking for any deadwood or damage seasonally.
- Don't plant too deep; pay attention to the root flare in relation to the surrounding grade. A tree too high or deep will result in a tree under stress.
