Create an explosion of color with this fantastic new reblooming selection. Loads of hot pink flowers in spring are followed by waves of blooms until frost! Mounded growth habit with deep green, deer resistant foliage. Reblooms without deadheading, providing seasonlong color in foundation plantings and borders. Oldfashioned weigela fills gardens with bright tubular flowers in early summer often blooming again as the season progresses. Summer foliage is neat and tidy, relatively disease free. The flowers are adored by **Hummingbirds!**



Reaches 4-5 feet tall and wide.





Partial to Full sun



Needs regular watering, weekly or more often in extreme heat.





- Do prune directly after flowering to avoid cutting off next season's potential blooms.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in exposed sites. Best growth occurs with protection from hot afternoon sun and drying winter winds.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
