
Moonshadow Wintercreeper



Lustrous, deep green leaves with bright yellow centers provide bold evergreen color in the landscape year-round. Use en masse as a vibrant groundcover or low hedge plant, or to create a colorful edging along drives and walkways. Works well as a container plant where spreading stems will create a lush, cascading effect.



Quickly reaches 3 feet tall; 5 feet wide.



Full to Partial Sun



Water deeply, regularly in first growing season to establish root system. Once established, reduce frequency; tolerates mild drought.



- Do site in full sun for best growth and coloration however the plant is at home in a dappled shade environment.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't plant in heavy deer/rabbit areas as winter browsing (feeding) can be severe.
- Don't neglect to provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
