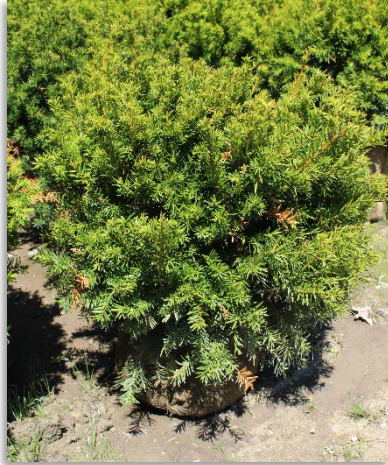


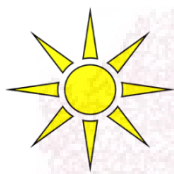
Dense Yew



This dense, low, spreading shrub is an excellent basic foundation planting for a hedge, screen or border. The dark green foliage backs scarlet-colored, berry-like cones. A versatile and durable evergreen that provides year-round interest in the landscape and tolerates shearing well.



Slowly reaches 3-4 feet tall; 4-6 feet wide.



Partial to full sun



Water regularly - weekly, or more often in extreme heat.



- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Don’t forget to provide antitranspirant/antidesiccant in late fall. This is especially important to new plantings or exposed sites.
- Don’t fertilize or prune too late in the season; we want new growth to harden off before the season first frost.
