

Moon Yew



This dense erect-rounded form also has upright shoots and branches. In general, form is broadly pyramidal with a central leader, the Yew has olive green branchlets which do not turn brown the second year.



Reaches 20 -30 feet tall and wide



Shade to Full Sun



Water Regularly – weekly, or more often in extreme heat



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid “clay bowls” that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.



- Don't forget to provide antitranspirant/antidesiccant in late fall. This is especially important to new plantings or exposed sites.
- Don't fertilize or prune too late in the season; we want new growth to harden off before the season first frost.
