

Upright Japanese Yew

Exceptional, dense, finely textured, shiny, dark green foliage is deer resistant. A splendid foundation plant or landscape specimen that is both heat and shade tolerant. Use to create a bold statement in formal groupings. Evergreen.



Slowly forms a broad, upright shrub 10 feet tall; 6-8 feet wide.

Partial Shade to Partial Sun



Water Regularly – weekly, or more often in extreme heat



- Do provide adequate drainage and avoid "clay bowls" that are notorious for holding water and predisposing plants to the compost heap.
- Do use sharp, clean tools when pruning; ragged stems and foliage from dull tools leaves your plants open to various pest and disease.
- Don't forget to provide antitranspirant/antidessicant in late fall. This is especially important to new plantings or exposed sites.
- Don't fertilize or prune too late in the season; we want new growth to harden off before the season first frost.
